# VINEYARD COURT SERVICES

A 6-12 month program of monthly in-home visits designed to support you and your child.

The program is designed to assist parents who have children ages 12 or older who:

- Have been or are currently in juvenile detention
- Are at-risk in being placed in juvenile detention
- Are court-referred

### Goals of the Program:

- To help you navigate the family court system successfully
- To decrease the likelihood of your child entering or re-entering juvenile detention
- To lower the chances your child will be truant, run away, abuse drugs and/or alcohol
- To take advantage of community resources to better support you and your child

### If You Have Been Court Referred to Participate:

- A case manager will contact you to set up an evaluation.
- A case manager will contact you about monthly home visits.
- During home visits, a case manager will work with you to connect you to community resources.
- The case manager will work with your child using Botvin Life Skills topics that include:
- Conflict Resolution, Communication, Decision Making, Healthy Relationships, & Understanding Risks.

### Parenting Support Offered:

This free, confidential class is offered every Tuesday from 6-8p.m. with snacks and drinks provided.
